

Pan-London Cancer Research Fellowship 2023/24

How to apply:

- Identify the project that you would like to undertake.
- You must contact the supervisor of the project only by email and not by phone.
- Send your CV (template attached) and a brief covering letter to the supervisor.
- You should contact the supervisor as soon as possible to allow time for your application to be considered.
- If you are selected to make an application, the supervisor will contact you to confirm the next stage of the application process. You will be asked to complete the 'Joint Pan-London Research Training Fellowship' application form, which will be completed jointly with the supervisor. The deadline for full applications is **18 December 2023.**
- Shortlisted applicants will be asked to attend a virtual panel interview, provisionally planned for week commencing 29 January 2024.

Following an initial call to potential supervisors, 44 projects have been selected. We will be looking to **fund up to four research fellows for 2023/24.**
