



GUIDE TO LCA SYSTEMIC ANTI CANCER THERAPY (SACT) NURSING COMPETENCY DOCUMENTS

Entry onto the Trust Chemotherapy Register

For nurses on completion of a chemotherapy qualification:

- Completion of Trust competencies such as medicines management/drug calculations
- Completion of a recognised chemotherapy qualification or completion of the London Cancer Alliance/The Royal Marsden workbook

For nurses from another Trust previously administering chemotherapy/SACT

- Completion of the LCA SACT safe handling and administration competency

Year 1 assessment to remain on the Trust Chemotherapy Register

- Completion of the LCA SACT safe handling and administration competency

Year 2 and subsequent years

- Completion of the LCA self-declaration of competence form

If a nurse has not been administering SACT for 2 years or more they must complete the LCA safe handling and administration competency and practical assessments prior to re-entry onto the Register.

Reassessment may take place at any time if there are any concerns over an individual's practice.
