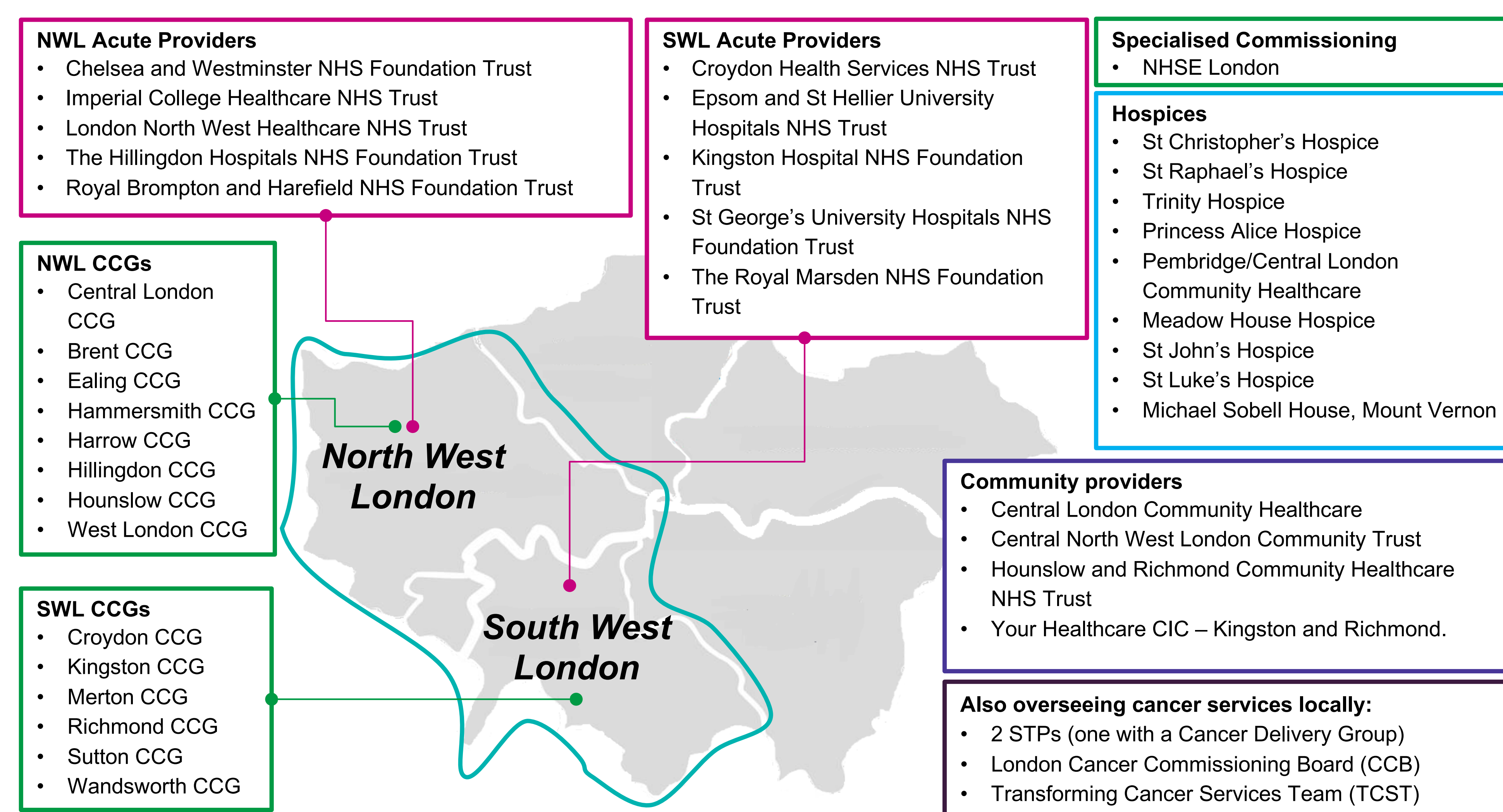


Our vision, aims and operating model

Working in partnership, **we will achieve world class cancer outcomes** for the population we serve

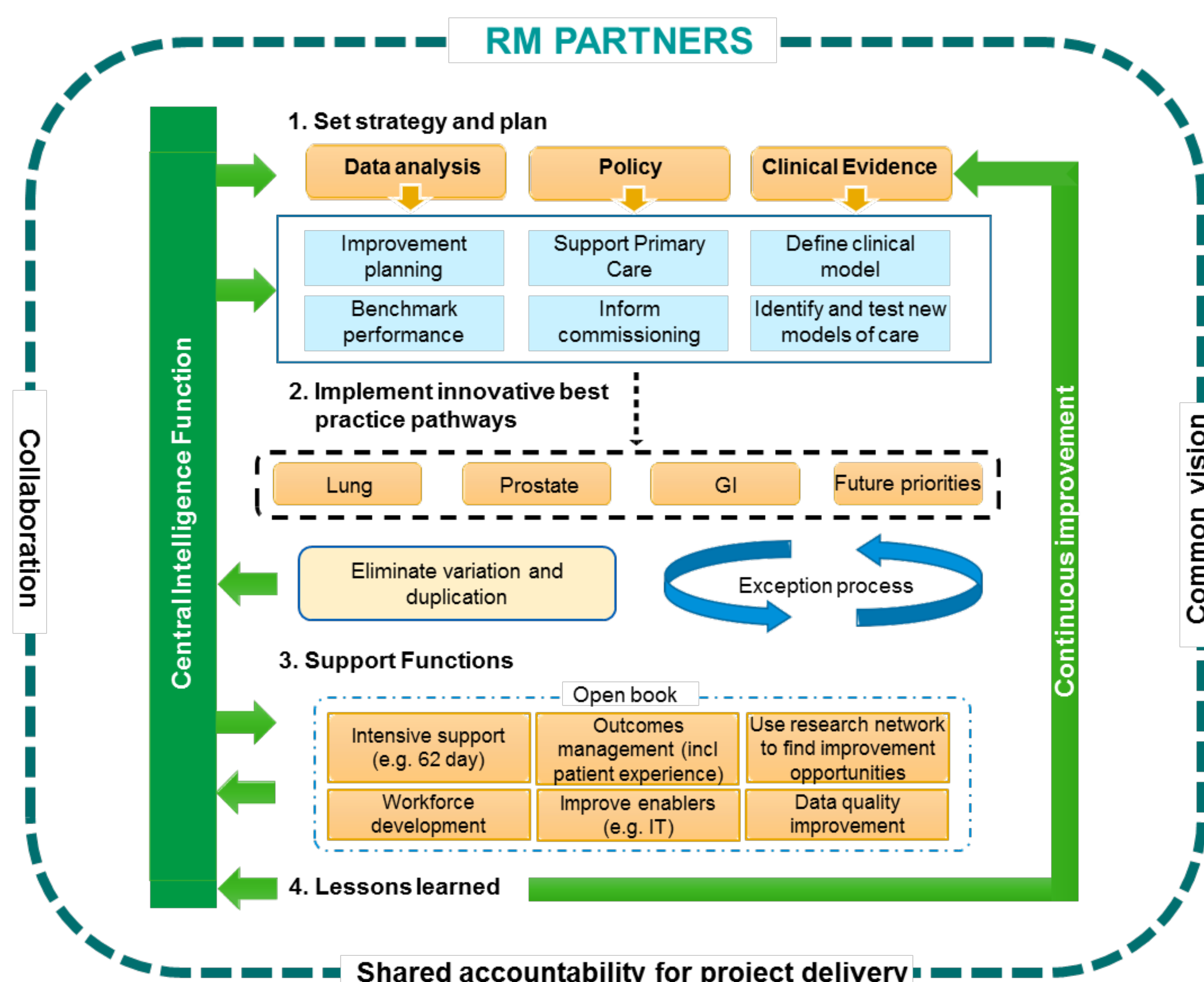
Our system

- Improve **efficiency** / reduce excess costs

How we operate



Within RM Partners, key strategic decisions are taken to the **RM Partners Executive Group** for approval. Membership of this group includes Chief Executive Officers from our member organisations and STP cancer leads.

Underpinning the Executive Group is our **Clinical Oversight Group**, which advises on setting clinical priorities and provides clinical opinion on RMP activities. Each provider Trust is represented on this group, which also includes primary care representation.

Our **Patient Advisory Group** (which provides patient opinion on transformation activities and advises on setting patient engagement priorities) is integral to our programme of change.

Also supporting our Executive Group are the **Delivery Group** (made up of COOs from member organisations) which is responsible for operational delivery of the transformation programme.
