

## Palliative Care Group Chair / Co-chair

1 Programmed activity per week (or 0.5 PA each if taken as job share)

**RM Partners (RMP)** is the Cancer Alliance across north west and south west London and covers a population of 3.9 million people. We are hosted by The Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust and work with healthcare organisations, including all NHS acute trusts in west London, two STPs (north west and south west London), clinical commissioning groups, specialised commissioning, community services, hospices and third sector and voluntary organisations.

Recruitment for this role is open to healthcare professionals working across north west and south west London only. A job share would be considered, if it reflected the diversity of roles in the palliative care and end of life care workforce.

The RMP Palliative Care Group meets on a six-weekly basis to share experience, best practice and innovation in the delivery of services across north west and south west London, with the additional involvement of colleagues in south east London. This is supported by the RM Partners senior leadership team, informatics services and project management.

The appointee(s) will provide leadership for 1 Programmed Activity (equivalent of 4 hours) per week (or 0.5 PA each if shared) to support the group's agenda, to chair the six-weekly meeting and regular stakeholder events. The appointee(s) will be accountable to the RM Partners Medical Director and may be subject to yearly review. Tenure is for a two-year period in the first instance.
