Alliance Planning Guidance Deliverables for Personalised Care

Full implementation of breast cancer personalised (stratified) follow up protocols by the end of 2019/20

- From April 2020 approximately two thirds of patients who finish treatment for breast cancer to be on a supported self management follow up pathway
- From diagnosis, all breast cancers patients (including secondary cancer) to have access to personalised care including needs assessment, a care plan, and health and wellbeing information and support

Alliance Planning Guidance Deliverables for Personalised Care

Clinically agreed protocols for stratifying prostate and colorectal cancer patients and systems for remote monitoring by end of 2019/20

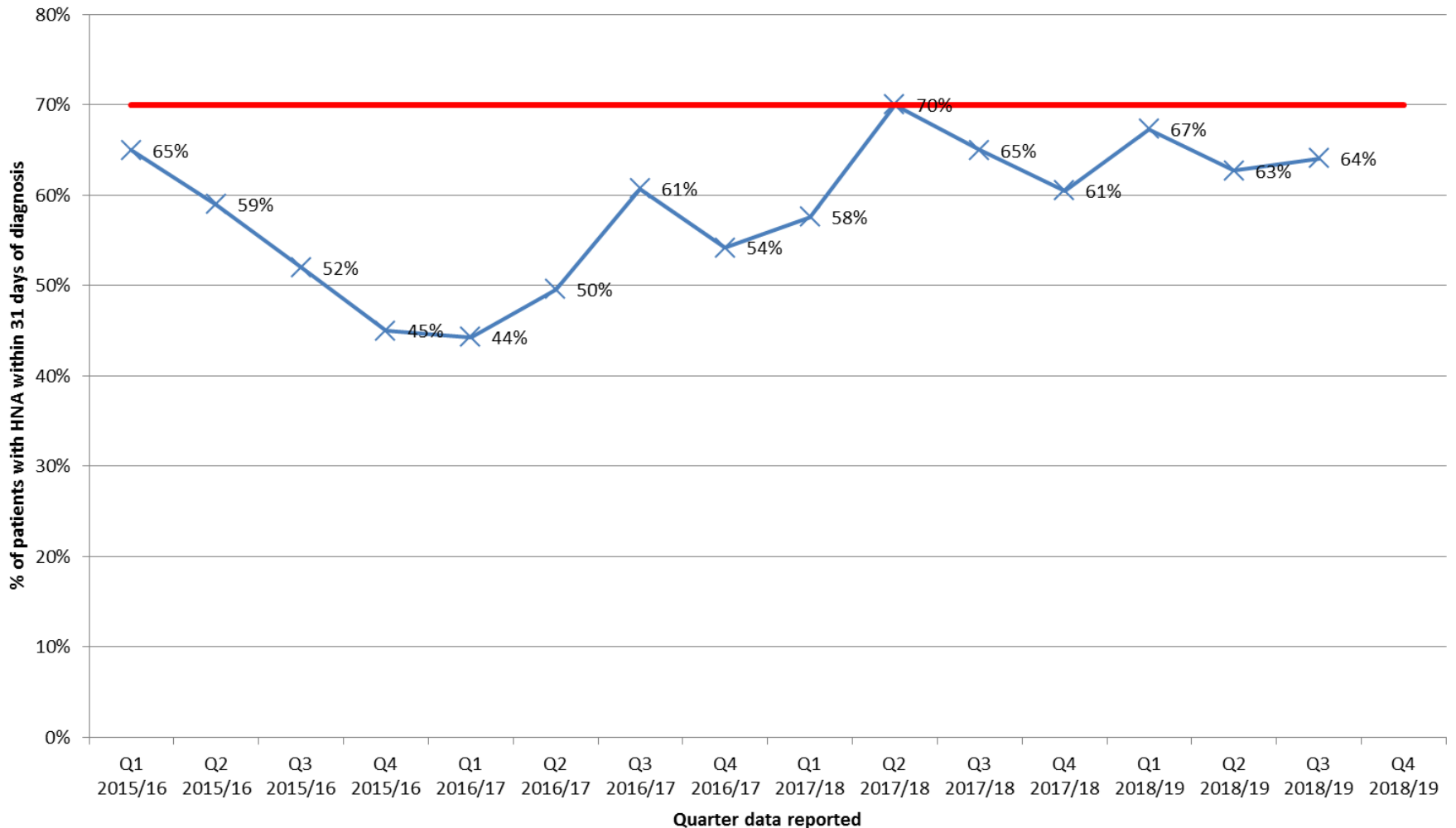
- All Alliance Trusts to have in place protocols for stratifying the follow up of prostate and colorectal patients and systems for remote monitoring for these patients
- From diagnosis, all colorectal and prostate cancer patients (including secondary cancer) to have access to personalised care, including needs assessment, a care plan and health and wellbeing information and support

RM Partners Personalised Care Projects

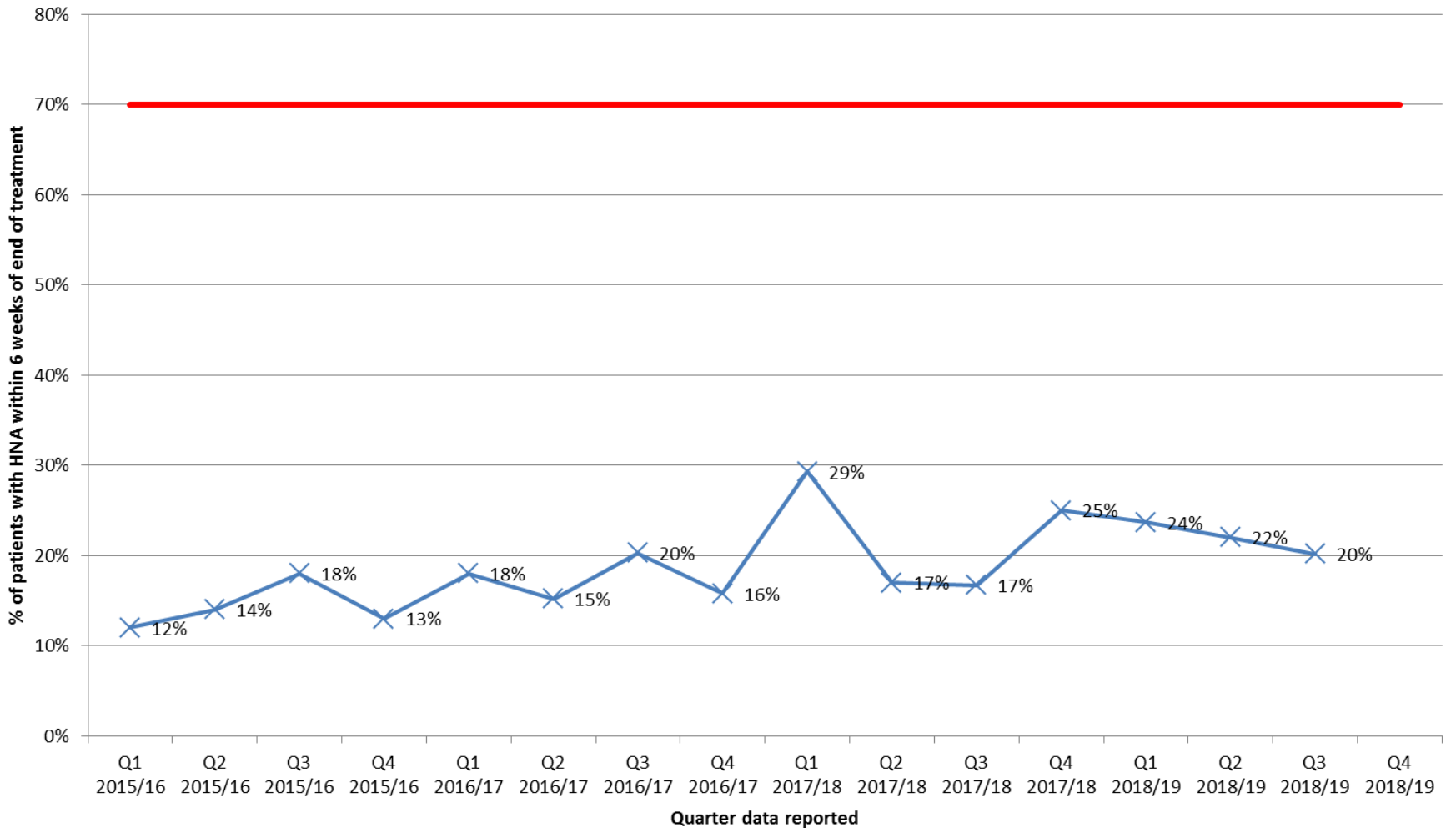
- Personalised Care deliverables are an amalgamation of the Recovery Package and Stratified Follow Up projects
- Building on implementation already started
- RM Partners Personalised Care Projects 2019/20 are likely to include:
 - Implementation of Personalised Follow Up
 - Implementation of interventions (previously grouped in Recovery Package) as enablers to personalised follow up
 - Prehabilitation, health and wellbeing support
 - Patient navigator role
- Funding is yet to be confirmed

Building on Recovery Package improvements across West London

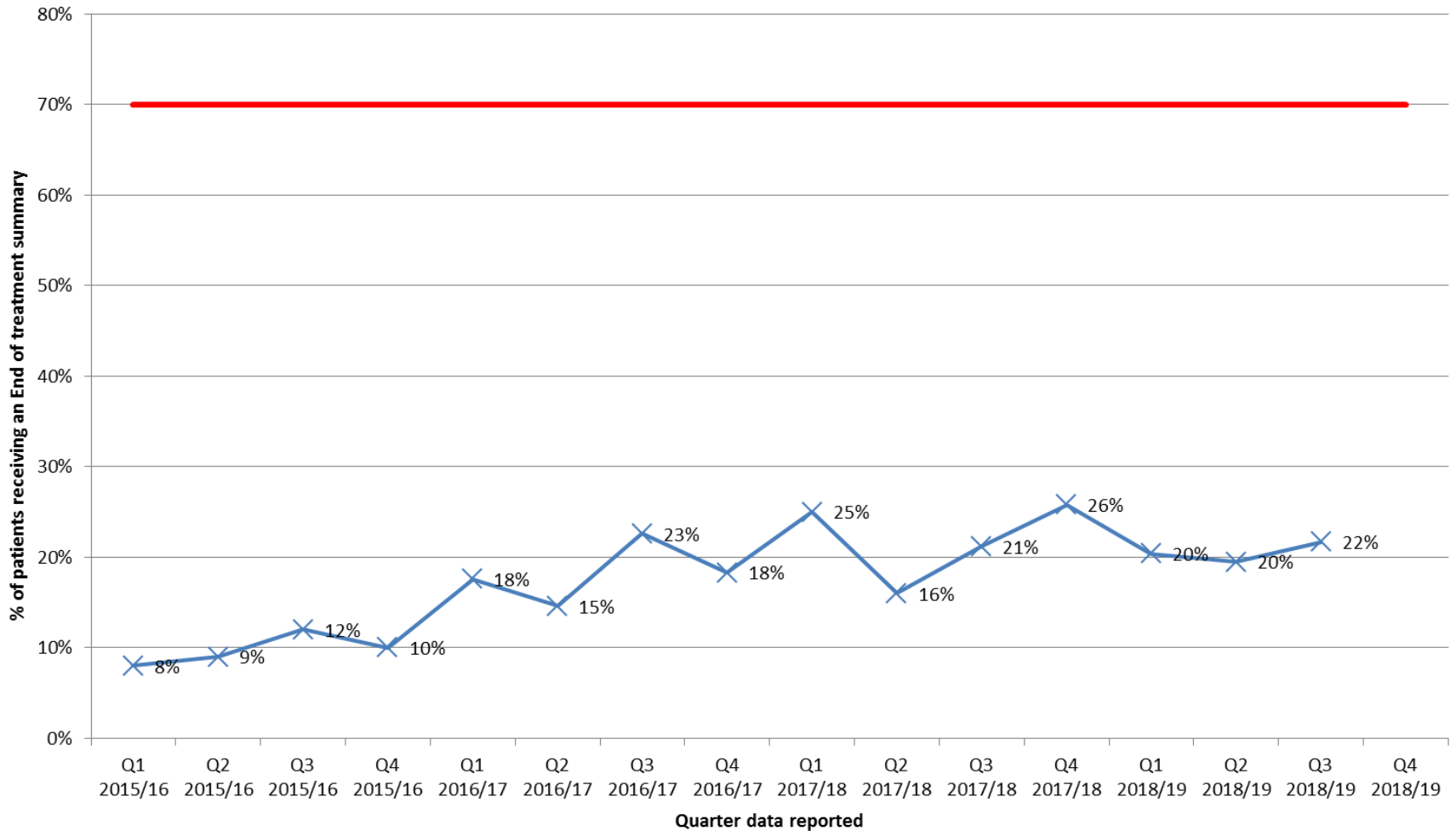
Graph showing the proportion of patients with a Holistic Needs Assessment completed within 31 days of diagnosis by quarter - RM Partners total



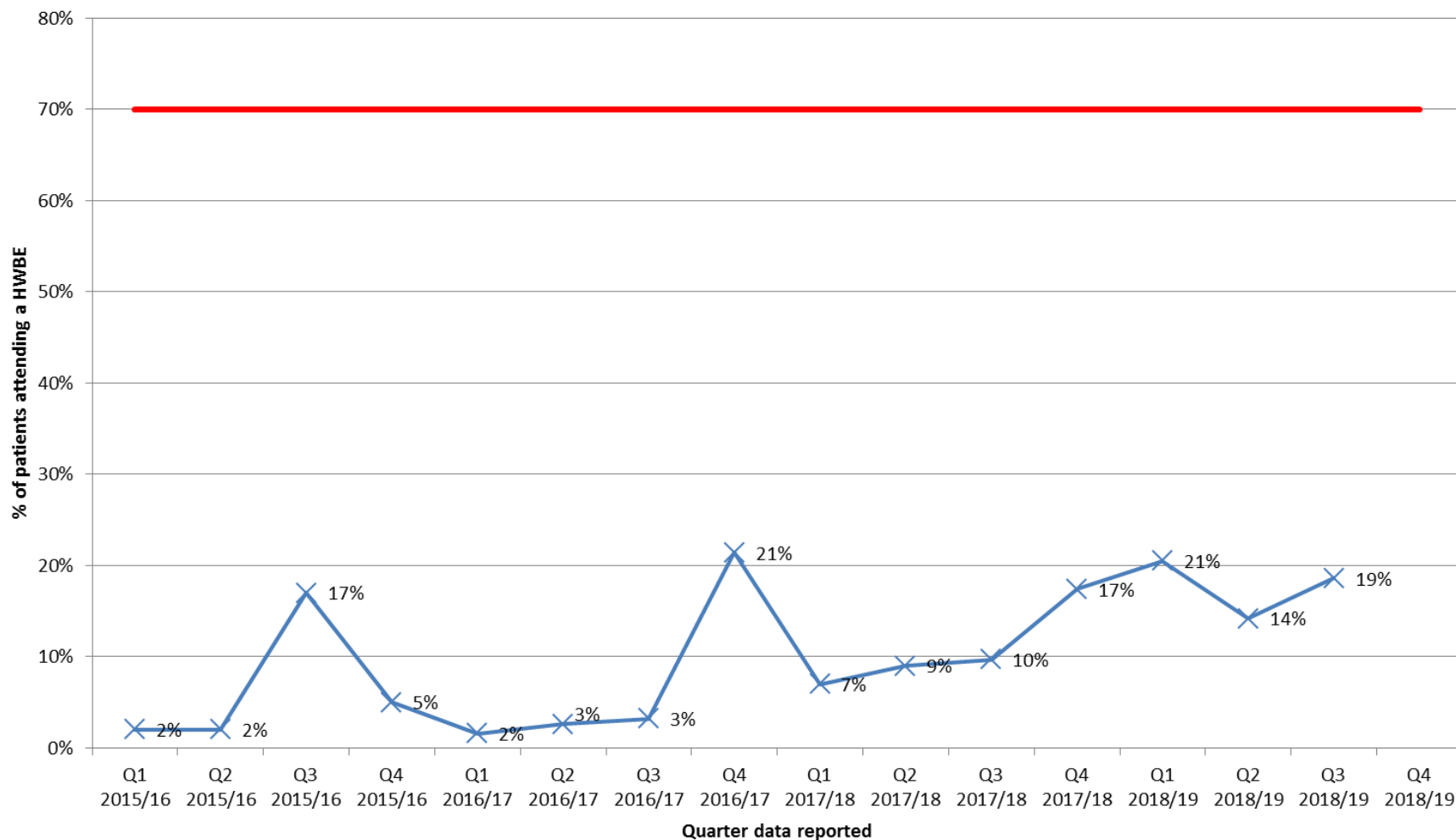
Graph showing the proportion of patients with a Holistic Needs Assessment completed within 6 weeks of end of treatment by quarter - RM Partners total

Electronic Holistic Needs Assessments

eHNA

- Implementation of eHNAs is a priority for this year, to improve recording of HNAs and encourage the use of electronic care plans
- Driven by the rich data from our Annual Audits in 2016 and 2017
- 2018 data should be available in June – requests will be coming out shortly
- eHNAs can be completed on Cancer system or the Macmillan eHNA tool
- Infoflex have an upcoming webinar on eHNAs on their system - please express interest to Maureen McGinn
- Macmillan eHNA tool – free support available from Macmillan’ Andrew Brittle and Amanda Watson
- Majority in our area on Somerset, with a small number on the Macmillan system and none on Infoflex (2017 data)
