The establishment of a cancer informatics team working across London and Greater Manchester to provide data to identify priorities for the Cancer Vanguard and emerging Cancer Alliances.

Outline

The Cancer Vanguard Informatics team has developed datasets of comparable metrics across the cancer pathway covering London and Greater Manchester.

The metrics have been split into seven sections for each tumour type. These sections are aligned with the priorities identified in the National Cancer Strategy, produced by the Independent Taskforce, and the NHS Five Year Forward View.

- Cancer waiting times
- Data quality
- Patient experience
- Prevent, early diagnosis and diagnostics
- Treatments
- Living with and beyond cancer
- Incidence, mortality, survival and prevalence information

The development of these metrics is achieved through a close working relationship with Public Health England, which holds the Cancer Outcomes and Services Datasets and also has significant analytical resource and expertise.

These have proved a valuable tool for the Cancer Vanguard as well as individual provider trusts and clinical commissioning groups to identify areas within their organisations for improvement.

For example, metrics were instrumental in identifying the Cancer Vanguard priority tumour types – colorectal, lung, upper GI and prostate cancers – as clinical experts were able to review benchmarked data to inform their decision making.
